## International Baccalaureate Preparation Program Payment Schedule – Year 10 (2025)

The International Baccalaureate Organisation is a not-for-profit organisation and so is Cleveland District State High School. There are a range of costs involved in completing the course including:

- Textbooks
- Approved Calculators
- Registration fees (for both the school and the individual student)
- Exam fees for every subject as well as the three core areas – CAS, EE and TOK.
- Compulsory Professional Development for staff and administrators of the Programme.
- Library resources purchased for IBDP student use.

The cost of the course for students who enrol at Cleveland District State High School for the three year program commencing in 2025 (Years 10, 11 and 12) will be \$4980. This cost is in line with the Education Legislation (Fees) Amendment Regulation 2018. Fees may be paid upfront for the year or by the term - \$415 per term payable at the end of week 3 each term. Please note that if a student leaves the IB program part way through the course, the term fee will apply for all full and partial terms of enrolment in the IB program.

Payment Schedule is:

- 31 August 2024 - deposit of \$415 paid on enrolment to secure a place in the course
- 15 February 2025
- 10 May 2025
- 2 August 2025
- 25 October 2025
- This payment plan will continue in 2026 and 2027 (no payment in Term IV of Year 12).
