1 Having all the necessary equipment for my subjects. For example:

- A notebook and/or laptop as per the subject requirements
- A student homework diary (Year 7)
- A fully equipped pencil case

2 Digital Readiness:

- Having a fully charged laptop (charged overnight), transported in a secure laptop case
- Using a USB storage device
- Having my ID Card for printing (with printer credit)
- If required, bringing a mouse and headphones
- Checking and managing my MIS school email account daily

3 Digital Organisation:

- Checking Daymap for messages, homework and lesson notes
- Backing up all school work to an external drive daily
- Creating a folder on my D Drive for each subject as per teacher instructions
- Only using my EQ email address to communicate with teachers

#### 4 Completing all homework and assignments.

- Recording all homework and assignment tasks in my student diary (Year 7) and/or electronic device (Daymap)
- Developing routine study habits by allowing enough time to complete set tasks, for example, Junior School 3-5 hours per week and possibly more during peak assessment periods
- Asking for help from teachers and attend homework assistance in the library if required
- Using the drafting process to get as much assistance as possible to improve my results
- Using the student assessment planner to help me and my parents/carers manage my time during the term
- Submitting all tasks by the due date
