Why Europe?

Showcase

Students develop team skills through experiencing the many aspects of presenting a showcase while travelling including the care and maintenance of instruments, costumes and artwork. The development of the showcase program and presenting in a variety of forums teaches the students to work, perform and think like a touring arts company.



Homestays

The month-long tour begins with homestays with students from two of our sister schools,

Parkside College of the Arts and Copenhagen International School. Both sister schools offer world-class education with a strong emphasis on the creative arts. By visiting these two schools, our students will have the opportunity to see first-hand what is being achieved in other international Creative Arts programs.
