Long stay - Study Abroad and Graduate Programs

** HOST FAMILIES RECEIVE TAX FREE PAYMENT of \$656 per fortnight per student

- Students from countries including (but not limited to) Germany, Italy, Brazil, China, Japan, Spain, Vietnam, Norway, Finland, France, Switzerland, Sweden, Austria, Chile etc.
- Study length: 3 months (1 term) to 6 years
- Male & female students
- Language ability varies
- Supply three meals per day plus snacks and drinks
- Must have their own bedroom with a bed, desk and wardrobe
- Access to all amenities
- Internet access
- Major intake periods January & July
- Placements can be single or double (1 of 2 students in each home)

Short Stays - STUDY TOURS

**HOST FAMILIES RECEIVE TAX FREE PAYMENT - \$43/day/student for Study Tours

- Students from countries such as Taiwan, China, Japan, South Korea
- Study length: 1 to 3 weeks
- Male &/or female students and/or teachers
- Language ability varies
- Must have their own bed but can share a room if more than 1 student
- Access to all amenities
- Internet access
- Supply three meals per day plus snacks and drinks
- Busiest period February/March & July/August
- Placements can be single or double (1 or 2, 3 students in each home) varies depending upon study tour
