REPRESENTATIVE SPORT POLICY

1. All players are required to attend all meetings, training sessions and games.
2. If a player will be absent from a game or training the student must notify their coach via email at the earliest possible time, preferably at least one day prior to the game or training session.
3. Players are required to be at all games at least 30 minutes prior to the starting time, unless notified by your coach.
4. Players are required to wear the full correct uniform to, from and during sport.
5. Players, parents and spectators must follow the Cleveland District State High School (CDSHS) Code of Conduct for all sporting events.
6. CDSHS staff have the right to withdraw players from the team if the player is not fulfilling their academic obligations at school, including attendance, performance, behaviour and effort.
7. Transport and supervision:
 - Wherever possible, CDSHS will arrange transport to and from the playing venues for games or competitions conducted during school hours
 - Parents/Guardians must provide transport to and from the playing venues for games outside of school hours, unless otherwise notified by the school.
8. Parents/Guardians have provided contact phone numbers and emergency contact details to the school. Please ensure that these remain up-to-date so that parents/guardians/emergency contacts can be contacted quickly in an emergency.
9. Players are expected to train at least once a week for representative level teams and be available to play the entire tournament to be eligible for team selection.
10. School sporting commitments take precedence over any "outside of school" sporting requirements. We are supportive of students playing for clubs, however if a player is selected for a school team, this school training and games will take precedence over club commitments. Wherever possible, school coaches will schedule training to minimise clashes with existing club commitments.
11. Players must adhere to the rules and regulations of the respective codes.

12. Any player sent from the field of play, for disciplinary reasons, is required to report to the HOD PE and Sport on the next timetabled school day for consultation and targeted strategies for improvement.
13. In school representative sport, including Bayside and Metropolitan Finals, the emphasis is very much on getting the best results possible. Players have been selected for specific roles within the team. Some of these roles may not involve the same amount of court or field time. Attitude, behaviour and attendance at training can also impact on court or field time.
14. Players, parents or family members are permitted to talk informally to coaches in a civil manner about issues that may arise. Any official complaints must be submitted in writing to the Head of Department (PE and Sport) within three days of the incident occurring. These official complaints will be reviewed by the HOD (PE and Sport) and members of the Executive Team.
