 - d) Proved reliable in carrying out co-curricular activities which involved expending considerable time and effort.

 - d) Shows by regularly volunteering services in a variety of activities a desire to promote the cultural life of the school.

This award is open to all students who have an ESL background. The student will be achieving well in a range of subjects and doing the best they can do. The student must be studying at Cleveland District State High School fulltime i.e. cannot be an exchange student who is here for three-six months.

Criteria for Selection

- a) Be achieving to the best of the student's ability.
- b) This award is based on Senior School performance.
- c) Students must be eligible for Tertiary entrance.
- d) The award will be based on the five (5) highest rating Authority subjects.
- e) Consideration will be given for totality of performance.
- f) Students will be given a rank order for each subject.
- g) Level of Achievement will be based on senior work to the end of Term 3.
- h) Students will be given points for each subject: 5 for a VHA, 4 for HA etc.
- i) The student with the highest number of points will be the recipient of the award.
- j) If students have an equal number of points the rank order in subjects in common will be used to decide the recipient.
- k) The award will not be given if the criteria have not been achieved.
